The Role

As a part-time FNP, you will be on the frontline of care, managing a diverse range of acute and chronic conditions in an environment where building relationships, developing trust and going the extra mile are key.

- **Clinical Care:** Diagnose and treat acute illnesses, minor injuries, and manage chronic conditions (HTN, Diabetes, Asthma) common in vulnerable populations.
- **Preventative Health:** Provide immunizations, screenings, and health education tailored to the realities of life on the street or in shelters.
- **Trauma-Informed Practice:** Deliver care through a lens of empathy, understanding the complex trauma and behavioral health needs of our patients.
- **Collaborative Referral:** Work closely with our social work and housing navigation teams to ensure patients receive holistic support beyond the exam room.

The Requirements

- **License:** Active, unrestricted RN and FNP license in Tennessee.
- **Certification:** Board Certified (AANP or ANCC).
- **Experience:** Minimum of 2 years of experience as an NP; prior experience with underserved populations, FQHCs, or street medicine is highly preferred.
- **Mindset:** You are comfortable with ambiguity, possess strong de-escalation skills, and believe that healthcare is a human right.
